






The above Pie-chart shows that 97% students believe the Institution is co-educational. Only 3% student does not agree with it.




Regarding documented policy of sexual harassment, 87% students give their positive response where as only 13% students do not agree with it.




Almost all students agreed that the documented policy regarding sexual harassment is available in the College Website.






All students (100%) who have been participated in the audit responded that the Institution has a committee to handle the sexual harassment inside the campus.



From the above pie-chart it is evident that, there is no discrimination regarding scholarship or fellowship based on merit by the College with respect to gender.




It is clear from the chart that, the College promoted the Students for caste based scholarship or fellowship irrespective of gender.







The above pie-chart suggested that, CCTV camera has installed in the campus.



Almost all students agreed that, orientation programmes was conducted at the commencement of each academic session.




Majority of the students responded that there are complaint box in the campus.







Above 95% of the students replied that gender sensitization programmes are held in the College.



Majority of the students (97%) agreed that there are no discrimination of gender in the sport and cultural field in the College.




From the above chart it is evident that the library and laboratories of the College are gender neutral.







Majority of the students think that the classrooms offer equal opportunities to all genders.




The above pie-chart it is clear that, adequate number of toilets is available for girls in the College campus.









The above Pie-chart shows that 97% students believe the Institution is co-educational. Only 3% student does not agree with it.



Majority of the students replied that the College has a documented policy to deal with sexual harassment.




Almost all students agreed that the documented policy regarding sexual harassment is available in the College Website.







All the students who have been participated in the survey agreed that Institution has a committee to prevent sexual harassment in the campus.



Majority of the students (91%) agreed that College promoted the students for merit based scholarship or fellowship irrespective of gender.




The above pie-chart clearly stated that, the College promoted the Students for caste based scholarship or fellowship irrespective of gender.







The above pie-chart suggested that, CCTV camera has installed in the campus.



Almost all students agreed that, orientation programmes was conducted at the commencement of each academic session to cater the students regarding curriculum.




Majority of the students responded that there are complaint box in the campus.







It is evident from the above pie-chart that the College organize gender sensitization programme in the campus.



Majority of the students (95%) think that, there is no discrimination of gender in the field of sports and culture.




Majority of the students (90%) agreed that the library and laboratories are gender neutral.









The above pie-chart it is clear that, adequate number of toilets is available for girls in the College campus.
