

Date: 05.01.2022

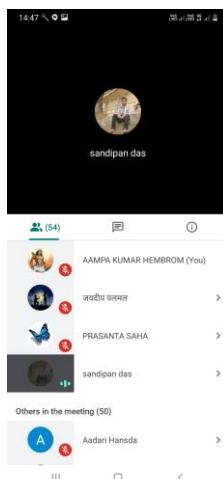

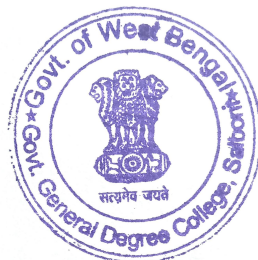


Conclusion:



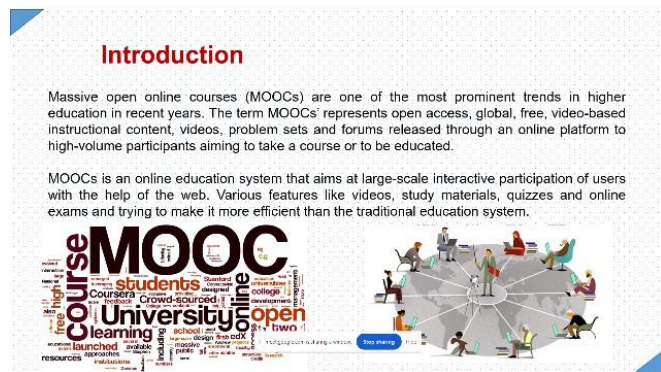

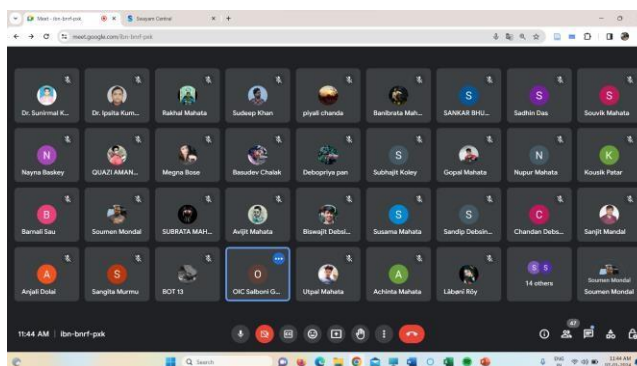
Observation of Students' Week (2nd January to 8th January, 2024)

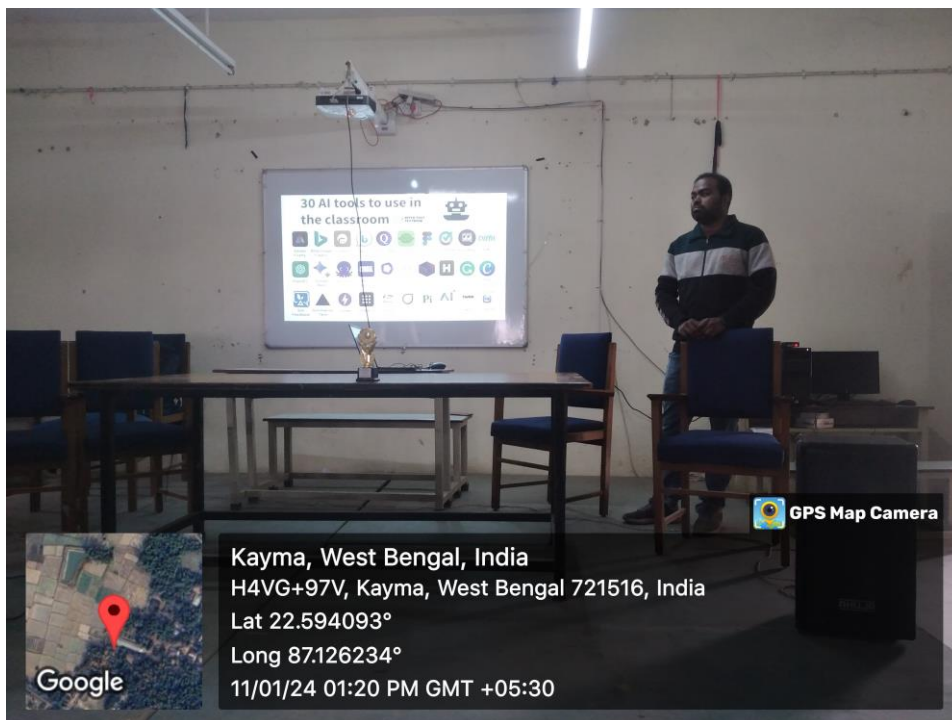

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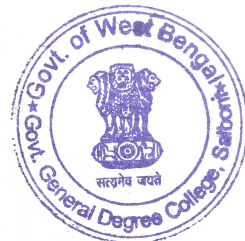
